

Royal Oak Schools Consolidation Plan

- Establish one high school in the 2006-2007 school year
- Establish one middle school in the 2007-2008 school year
- Establish six elementary schools anticipated by the 2008-2009 school year
- Predicated on the closure of:
 - Dondero High
 - Kimball High
 - Addams MS
 - Keller MS
 - Longfellow El
 - Mark Twain El
 - Starr El
 - Whittier El
 - Lincoln ECC
 - BOE/Central Office

Royal Oak Schools Consolidation Plan

- Establishes Royal Oak High School (former Kimball site)
- Establishes Royal Oak Middle School (former Dondero site)
- Establishes six elementary sites: Addams, Keller, Northwood, Oakland, Oak Ridge, Upton
- Moves Early Childhood to Addams Elementary and BOE/Central office to Keller Elementary

Royal Oak Schools

Consolidation Plan for Effective Transition

- Royal Oak High School – Concludes in September, 2006
- Royal Oak Middle School – Operates through 2006-2007 school year. Chaired by Executive Director, Carol Hansen
- Royal Oak Elementary Schools – Commences September, 2006 – Chaired by Executive Director, Barbara Evoe

Royal Oak Schools

Consolidation Plan for Elementary Schools

- Will be based on the school district's experience in closure of elementary schools
- Will consider comfortable service loads for student populations and service staffs
- Will consider greater service capacities at Keller El, Addams El and new Northwood El
- Will continue open enrollment on a space-available basis
- Will consider walk distances and transportation demands

Royal Oak Schools

Consolidation Plan for Elementary Schools

- *Moves Mark Twain to Oak Ridge Elementary
- Moves Whittier and Central Office to Keller Elementary
- *Moves Longfellow, Starr and Early Childhood to Addams Elementary

*No formal BOE resolution to date

Flexibility must be maintained as this plan evolves through planning to implementation.
